Graduate Academic Scholarship Application Information and Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. There are different levels of Academic Scholarships with different eligibility requirements and amounts. See each individual scholarship below for more information. For complete eligibility requirements, please see the Financial Aid Handbook.
- 2. Graduate Academic Scholarships are awarded based on the final cumulative GPA at the college/university where the student earned a bachelor's degree.
- 3. Students must enroll in 6 or more hours per semester to be eligible for an Academic Scholarship.
- 4. In order for a Graduate Academic Scholarship to be awarded, SAGU must have received an official transcript from the college/university where the student earned a bachelor's degree.
- 5. Graduate Academic Scholarships can be renewed if the student maintains a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 and continues to be enrolled at least half-time (6 or more hours per semester).

- \$1,000 is awarded annually (\$500 per semester)
- Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.50 3.74

Vice Presidential Scholarship

- \$1,500 is awarded annually (\$750 per semester)
- Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.75 3.89

Presidential Scholarship

- \$2,000 is awarded annually (\$1,000 per semester)
- Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.90 4.00
