
# SOUTHERN BIBLE COLLEGE A TEXAS INSTITUTION



Southern Bible College opens its Fall term on Monday, October 5, 1931. The school year will consist of three terms of three months each. Opening schedule is as follows:

Friday and Saturday, October 2-3 ...... Matriculation Sunday, October 4 ...... Official Welcome to Students Monday, October 5 ...... Opening of Term

Teaching headquarters of Southern Bible College will be housed in the big new building illustrated above. This is TRINITY TABERNACLE, just completed at a cost of about \$16,500. It is a two-story concrete building. Class-rooms on the first floor and church auditorium on the second floor. Thirteen class-rooms and a lecture hall on the first floor will be occupied by Southern Bible College. This building was especially erected as a combination church and Bible College structure and is regarded as being a model for convenience. Church auditorium seats 800 persons comfortably.

Dormitory facilities have been provided through the kindness of a member of TRINITY TABERNACLE, who has given Southern Bible College the use of a dormitory building, kitchen, etc., capable of housing all students.

### COURSES OF STUDY

Southern Bible College will give a standard three-year Bible College Course, including Old and New Testament, Church History and Doctrine, Theology, Prophecy and Dispensations; Homiletics, English, Piano, Vocal Music, etc.

It is the object of Southern Bible College to give the young minister or other Christian worker a Bible education that will not only be thorough, but will also be practical. A large portion of the students' time in Southern Bible College will be consumed in practical work and in prayer. We will endeavor to place before the student only those studies actually necessary to his or her future work, and through the Practical Work Department it will be possible for the student to immediately put the theories learned into actual practice in one of the many preaching stations available to our students.

#### FACULTY

The faculty of Southern Bible will compare favorably with that of any other Bible college. Most of the faculty have already moved to the College and are now actively preparing their courses for the Fall term. The members of the faculty already selected are:

- J. T. Little ..... President Eighteen years pastor and evangelist. Trained at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas, as well as other schools. Many years' experience in religious education and editorial work.
- Twenty-six years in the Pentecostal movement. Former missionary to the Modoc Indians in Oklahoma. Pastor and evangelist for years. Has specialized in religious educational work.
- Graduate Robert E. Lee School; specialized in piano instruction.
- Graduate School of Sacred Music of Fort Worth; teacher of many years' experience; evangelistic song leader and choir director of several large churches. Regarded as one of the best teachers in the South.

Other members of the faculty are being added at this time, and will be ready to take up their duties by the time the Fall term opens. In addition we are making arrangements for the following to visit the College for a combination lecture and revival campaign during the winter:

Frederick E. Childe, noted lecturer on prophetic subjects.

Dr. Charles Shreve, nation-wide evangelist.

Visiting ministers of the District will also be at the College from time to time and lecture to the student body.

## LOCATION

Southern Bible College is located in what is known as the "TRI-CITIES." only a short distance from Houston, Texas, the largest city in the State and one of the largest in the entire South. Students will have unexcelled opportunities in Houston for practical work with foreigners, Mexicans. sailors and in slum work, as well as in numerous missions and churches where invitations have already been extended.

The TRI-CITIES, where the College is located, are so named because of the three cities of Goose Creek, Pelly and Baytown, which are located in this area and which practically constitute one town with a population of

close to 20,000 persons. The College is located in Goose Creek, one mile from beautiful San Jacinto Bay, which is an arm of Galveston Bay and the Gulf of Mexico. Students will enjoy the recreational facilities provided by this great body of water, as well as the other bays and streams in the vicinity.

The winter climate on the Gulf Coast is ideal; flowers bloom practically every month in the year; fresh vegetables are available from gardens even in the middle of winter; cool breezes from the bay keep one from getting excessively warm, and good roads in every direction make traveling easy. Numerous outstations, missions and churches will be provided students. In fact, the opportunities for the student to "learn to preach by preaching" are unexcelled.

#### A RECOMMENDED SCHOOL

The head of the College is Rev. J. T. Little, pastor of Trinity Tabernacle, one of the largest Assemblies of God churches in the State. Bro. Little is also Presbyter for the Houston section of the Assemblies. The Sectional Convention of the Houston section has recommended Southern Bible College, as follows:

## LOWEST COST TO STUDENTS

In order to make it possible for students from every part of the District to attend Southern Bible College, we have made every effort to hold down the costs to a minimum. These low costs are only possible through the co-operation of a number of churches, and are as follows:

Board, Room and Tuition (per month) \$12.00 Library Fees (per term) 1.00 Laundry Fees (per term) 1.00

Under the above schedule the actual costs of attending Southern Bible College for one year will be about \$114.00, which INCLUDES board, room and tuition. Books will come extra, and students should allow for this.

Young women students are expected to bring an adequate supply of plain white dresses of modest style and length, and at least two colored dresses.

Each student will be required to furnish four sheets, four pillowcases, two blankets (or quilt) and six heavy towels.

#### NOTICE TO CHURCHES

Southern Bible School requests pastors and churches to assist its students meet their living expenses. Numbers of our students will find it impossible to meet their expenses unless they have help, yet they are choice young people, and God has a work for them to do. If you would like to help these students you may do so by either donations of MONEY or of FOOD. Several churches have agreed to send us a weekly or monthly box of groceries. They will "take up a pounding" among their membership and forward their boxes prepaid.
