


GREATER WITH FAITH











POPULAR DEGREES AMONGST STUDENT ATHLETES

BASEBALL & SOFTBALL: Both programs received Sooner Athletic Conference postseason honors and produced multiple NAIA Scholar-Athletes.


FOOTBALL: Joseph Chavez named 1st Team All-Conference and 2nd Team NAIA All-American.
